THE COMMUNICATIONS ACT OF 1995. . . . The landscape of the radio industry was forever changed Thursday as both the House and Senate passed the telecom bill, which eliminates national ownership caps. The measure passed in the House 414 to 16, then flew through the Senate by a vote of 91 to 5. The President is expected to sign the bill. Look for a flurry of station trading activity as station owners look to further dominate market areas or eliminate competitors. The legislation is the most significant for broadcasting since the Communications Act of 1934.

The final version varies the number of stations one can own in a market, depending on the number of signals that overlap the stations in question. In those signal areas with 45 or more stations, one can own eight stations, but no more than five can be in the same band. With 30-44 stations, seven stations can be owned, no more than four in one band. In areas with 15-29 stations, you can own six stations, still with no more than four in a service. In areas with fewer than 15 stations, one can own up to half of them, with no more than three in one band. The Commission will now have more leeway for one-to-a-market waivers, being able to grant them in markets 26-50 as well as 1-25. Licenses will now be renewed for eight years. There will be no comparative license renewal hearings.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Center for Study and Application of Black Economic Development lost its bid for renewal of KUCB-FM, Des Moines this week as the Commission denied its application along with the application of Iowa Acorn Broadcasting Corp. for review of the denial of the renewal application. The Center's president was convicted in federal court for impersonation of an attorney, conspiracy, racketeering, and embezzlement. The Commission believes he hid these facts when testifying during a license renewal hearing.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The Commission denied a petition for reconsideration filed by the State of Oregon for review of the dismissal of its application for a new educational FM in Redding, CA. Oregon's application was dismissed as untimely filed. Oregon argued that two cut-off dates constituted an FCC prejudicial procedural error. According to a dissenting statement issued by Commissioner Susan Ness, the Commission either made mistakes or ignored several requests for a clarification of the cut-off date.

The FCC has rescinded a \$25,000 fine for EEO violations to Dennis Elam, trustee for Bakcor Broadcasting, which was the licensee of KMND and KNFM, Midland, TX. The Commission concluded the violations took place while Bakcor was licensee and the fine would unduly punish creditors.

The Commission has affirmed the Mass Media Bureau's action which granted the application of Roberts Communications, Inc. to modify the facilities of WXOD, Winchester, NH. The Bureau's action was affirmed over the objections of L.B. New Hampshire, Inc., which owns WKNE-AM & FM, Keene, NH. L.B. unsuccessfully argued the new facilities did not meet the Commission's Suburban Community Standard.

The NAB Board elections are in their final stage. NAB Radio members have elected nine Board representatives, and will conduct run-off voting in three districts. Ballots are due back to the NAB March 1. The districts with run-offs scheduled are District 4 (DE, DC, MD, and VA), District 8 (LA and MS), and District 14 (IA and WI).

Competition among radio stations in Casper, WY will be a lot tougher in the near future. Three applicants for a new FM station on 97.3 MHz have filed applications to amend the allocation table to add two new channels to the market so that each may have their own frequency. The new allocations will give Casper, a market of just under 50,000 people, seven commercial FM stations in addition to its three AM's and two non-commercial FM's.

Last year, Bruce L. Erickson, Hart Mountain Media, and Rule Communications each filed for the new station on 97.3 MHz. After realizing they could squeeze in a couple more channels to the market, they filed to add two new channels and keep their cut-off protection, essentially keeping the filing window closed, since no one else filed for the 97.3 frequency when it was first made available.

The result will be Erickson retaining the sole application for 97.3 MHz. Hart Mountain Media will get 102.5 MHz while Rule Communications will move to 104.7 MHz. Hart Mountain already owns adult hits KTRS, Casper, on 95.5 MHz.

Mt. Rushmore Broadcasting, who owns classic rocker KASS and country KQLT in that market, filed petitions against the move, based on the economic hardship the new stations would cause in that market. Their argument relied on the pending NAB request to the Commission asking it to review its allocation policies so that economic factors, not just technical factors, would be reviewed when granting a new channel.

The Commission denied the petition, stating that it has already determined that the consideration of "economic feasibility issues (is) not relevant."

Rule Communications did the same thing in Cheyenne with KRAE, Inc., creating two new FM stations out of one allocation. Rule will keep its cut-off protection for a new channel on 99.9 MHz while KRAE will retain its application for 104.9 MHz. An allotment for a class C on 99.9 MHz at Saratoga, WY was deleted to accommodate the action.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

Cheyenne is a market of just over 60,000 people. Before the new allotments, the market has six commercial FM's and four AM's. Two FM's and an AM are silent. No petitions were filed against the Cheyenne allotments.

FCC Administrative Law Judge Joseph P. Gonzalez retired on December 30, 1995, after 15 years with the Commission and 28 years of government service. He previously served as an ALJ for the Labor Department.

ELSEWHERE

In Pittsburgh, Sheridan Broadcasting and Secret Communications will be swapping frequencies. Secret's new rock WXDX, Beaver Falls will get Sheridan's 105.9 MHz frequency. Sheridan's urban WAMO-FM, Pittsburgh will get 106.7 MHz frequency and \$10 million for their trouble. Sheridan also owns urban oldies WYJZ, Pittsburgh. Secret has album rocker WDVE, Pittsburgh.

EXCL Communications is branching out of its native California to pick up Century Broadcasting's Denver combo: dance hits KYBG, Denver and new rock sister KNRX, Castle Rock. Terms weren't disclosed. EXCL has stations in the San Jose and Monterey Bay/Salinas markets.

Rainbow Broadcasting has sold its Phoenix FM KBZR-FM, Coolidge, AZ to a group of investors that includes programming consultant Jerry Clifton. The group, NPR Phoenix, L.L.C, was formed to acquire the CHR outlet by Clifton, Scott Fey, and Albert Bracht. Glenn Serafin handled the seller's side of the transaction.

Osborn Communications Corp. is doubling up in the Wheeling, WV market by adding soft AC WHLX, Bethlehem, WV to its collection there. It will spend \$800,000 with Bethlehem Radio, Inc. to combo the station with country sisters WWVA and WOVM.

Arbitron's redesigned market reports will hit the streets for the Winter '96 book after a "real-life" production run performed in parallel with the Fall '95 book proved successful. The redesigned market report loses the hour-by-hour section, but adds multibook averages for the Target Listener estimates and a Time Spent Listening section. Arbitron will have info on the new books available at the RAB's Managing Sales Conference in Dallas.

Radio Canada International fans may not have to worry about their favourite broadcasts disappearing. The Canadian government was to discontinue the broadcasts March 31 because of funding problems. A story in the Wall Street Journal says a strong campaign to save the service will keep it on the air. It provides over 230 hours of programming each week. RCI has a budget of \$12 million (U.S.).

One call could buy you advertising on the majority of Spokane's radio stations soon as Triathlon announced it will buy Silverado's three stations there, gold-based AC KISC, country KNFR and standards/talk KAQQ. This is in addition to the four it agreed to buy from Pourtales, oldies combo KEYF-AM & FM, classic rock KKZX, and religion KUDY. Silverado also has sales agreements in place with country KCDA and rocker KNJY while Triathlon has sales agreements with Citadel's news-talk KGA and KJRB, country KDRK, and new rock KAEP. If Triathlon is able to buy all seven stations and keep the sales agreements, it will control the sales for 13 stations with a combined total week 12+ share near 70.

RANDY'S BIG DAY . . . Randy Michaels' Jacor Communications has been busy while Congress debated the telecom bill. It will buy the entire Noble Broadcast Group for \$152 million. The deal will give Jacor 36 stations, including four AM's and four FM's in Denver and an FM duopoly in San Diego. Jacor has secured a \$300 million credit line for future acquisitions, according to its press release. Jacor will assume the operating agreement for XETRA-AM & FM, Tijuana/San Diego. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

With the stroke of both a regular pen and a digital pen on an electronic tablet, President Clinton signed the telecom bill into law. The new radio ownership rules take effect immediately. Rulemaking by the FCC will happen soon to encompass all of the changes.

The Commission finally approved the Disney/Capital Cities/ABC, Inc. merger with a unanimous vote this week. Commissioners Jim Quello and Rachele Chong wanted the one-year cross-ownership waivers in Dallas and Detroit to be permanent. The Commission will soon review the cross-ownership regulations, which may eliminate the need for the waivers. The Justice Department blessed the deal last month, provided that the new company spins off one of its two television stations in Los Angeles. The FCC has given them six months to accomplish that.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The Commission has affirmed a decision by the Mass Media Bureau which granted the application of Heartland Radio, Inc. for a construction permit to modify the facilities of KEZH, Hastings, NE and denied Central Nebraska Broadcasting Company's request for a review of that action. Central is the licensee of KQKY, Kearny, NE. Heartland sought to upgrade the facilities of KEZH by moving to a higher class channel. Objecting to Heartland's request, Central contended that the transmitter tower, upon which Central also leases space, cannot safely support the addition of KEZH's antenna.

Denying review, the Commission found that Central failed to show that the tower was unsafe or that there was any other error warranting reconsideration of the Bureau's decision.

Budget cuts are hitting the FCC hard. This week, the Commission decided to eliminate the Review Board as of March 29, 1996. The Board reviews Initial Decisions of Administrative Law Judges and other related hearing matters. Matters which remain pending before the Board on March 29 will be certified to the Commission for action.

A lack of money has also forced the Commission to severely limit the information provided on the public notices. The notices are issued so any interested parties are notified of any Commission action. Broadcast Applications and Broadcast Actions, two of the most critical notices for broadcasters, have historically provided detailed information on any facility change, new station, translator, assignment or transfer, etc. In the future, these documents will only list the nature of the change (e.g. on a facility change, "app. to change ERP, HAAT, xmtr location") rather than listing the specific power, height, and coordinates. Assignment and Transfer notices will list only the transferring licensee and the transferor and the type of form filed. *M STREET: It took us a little by surprise, but we will continue to provide all the information we have traditionally provided, including facilities and complete station sale information.*

ELSEWHERE

SFX Broadcasting is working on a deal that will net them four stations in the Greenville/Spartanburg market, up the stations it controls in Jackson, MS to six, and complete the previously-announced purchase of Liberty Broadcasting. SFX is doubling up in Greenville/Spartanburg through a complex station swap where Multi-Market will buy rocker WROQ, Anderson, SC from ABS Communications for \$14 million. The station will then be sold to SFX to combo with its three other stations there--news-talker WGVL, Greenville; country WSSL-FM, Gray Court; and AC WMYI, Hendersonville. Multi-Market will buy black gospel WZRZ and rocker WSTZ, Vicksburg, MS from Lewis Broadcasting for \$3.5 million, then spin them to SFX, which will combo them with sports WJDS, country WMSI, and country WKTF.

Sandusky Newspapers is buying Park's Seattle combo for \$26 million. Business news KEZX and jazz KWJZ will combo with Sandusky's adult standards KIXI, Mercer Island and AC KLSY-FM, Bellevue. Sandusky has properties in Phoenix and Dallas, as well.

Infinity is selling instead of buying this week. It's dumping its Seattle country outlet KYCW for \$26 million to EZ Communications. It's a natural for EZ, which owns country combo KMPS-AM & FM and classic rocker KZOK-FM. The deal will give EZ a total of 22 stations in eight markets.

Nationwide Communications is expanding into California by picking up Lotus Communications' KFSD, San Diego. Terms weren't disclosed. The classical station is NCI's first California station and gives the group 13 stations.

Regent Communications is getting out of the Dayton market by selling its FM duopoly of soft AC WLQT, Kettering and oldies WDOL, Englewood, OH to Palm Beach Radio Broadcasting. No terms were disclosed. Palm Beach owns WPBZ, West Palm Beach.

Tom Ingstad's Broadcast Group is buying up two more stations in the Yakima market, bringing its total to five there. Ingstad will buy oldies KMWX and CHR KFFM from Northwest Broadcasting Company, Inc. for an undisclosed price. Ingstad currently owns news-talker KIT and rock KATS, Yakima; and country KXXS, Toppenish, WA. The stations will enter into a sales agreement soon.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

Talk and sports KVEG, North Las Vegas will go to Crescent Communications for \$1.8 million. Crescent owns AC KMZQ, Henderson and classic rock KFBI, Pahump there as well as properties in San Francisco and Albuquerque.

The ten year deal also requires a radio network of at least 60 stations throughout the region. Dick and Raleigh's Capitol Networks will team up to do the network. The deal begins for the 1998 season. The agreement also gives WGFX and Dick's WIVK, Knoxville rights to broadcast the 1996 and 1997 season games, as well. The Nashville Tennessean estimates the deal to be valued between \$2 and \$3 million for the first year.

JACOR DEAL OF THE WEEK. . . It's been a feeding frenzy this week as the new ownership rules take effect. The biggest mega-deal is the purchase of Cincinnati-based Citicasters by Randy Michaels' Jacor Communications. The \$774 million deal gives Jacor complete market dominance in markets like Cincinnati and Denver. Jacor will pay \$29.50 per Citicasters share, plus approximately 1/5 of a warrant per fully diluted Citicasters share. The warrants will permit Citicasters shareholders to purchase a Jacor share for \$28. Coupled with the recently announced deal to buy Noble Broadcasting, Jacor will own 54 radio stations, including a full compliment of four AM's and four FM's in Denver, four FM's, two AM's, and a TV station in both Cincinnati and Tampa, and five radio stations in Columbus and Jacksonville.

Next in line is SFX Broadcasting's plan to purchase Prism Radio Partners for \$105.25 million. The deal will give SFX 51 stations in 16 markets. The new group will have new duopolies in Louisville, Jacksonville, Raleigh-Durham, Tucson, and Wichita, in addition to the nine other markets where SFX has duopolies. No word on the fate of Prism's executives in the deal.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Under the weight of a massive budget shortfall, the Commission continues to trim to the bone. Billed as "efficiency moves" and "streamlining", the Commission is consolidating departments, eliminating paperwork, and virtually eliminating technical information from public notices. Following the Mass Media Bureau's removal of all technical information from Broadcast Applications and Actions, it adopted streamlined licensing rules and procedures for Fixed Microwave Services, and Broadcast EEO Policies and Forfeitures. It's also consolidating the Common Carrier and Private Carrier Paging Services. The Commission eliminated the Review Board last week, as well. It's asking for your suggestions in cutting back even further.

The moves result in both good news and bad news for broadcasters. The FCC has now made it difficult to garner broadcast facilities information, which may affect the ability to make decisions regarding upgrades or new stations in your area.

On the other hand, the proceeding for the Commission's streamlining of EEO requirements may give small market broadcasters a break from burdensome regulations.

The Commission is seeking comment on which stations might qualify for reduced EEO recordkeeping and filing requirements or, in some cases, be exempted from these duties altogether. Categories being considered include the station's staff size, market size, and the size of the local minority labor force. The Commission is exploring several possible options for relief for qualifying stations. Under one approach, stations would only have to certify that their staff size is below a certain threshold and would then be exempt from further reporting requirements. Under another approach, the Commission would maintain reporting requirements, but allow broadcasters a choice of possible recruitment options, one of which might be regular participation in recruiting events like job fairs.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

The Commission also asked for comment on an industry proposal to permit broadcasters not to retain detailed job-by-job recruitment records if their employment profiles meet certain benchmarks.

The Commission is proposing to give broadcasters credit for using the recruiting resources of a central source, such as a state broadcast association, under certain conditions. The Commission called for any other proposals that would minimize paperwork burdens and improving the current test under which stations may evaluate their EEO efforts with reference to a labor force other than the one in the station's Metropolitan Statistical Area.

The Commission is also looking for comment on proposed guidelines for imposing forfeitures for EEO violations. Since the Commission's guidelines were vacated by a court of appeals in 1994, it has processed renewal applications on a case-by-case basis without reference to the guidelines.

The FCC is asking for your suggestions on which procedures or processing functions should be completely eliminated as well as ways in which it can eliminate paperwork. Other questions the Commission is asking are:

Are there procedures or functions that could be privatized or "outsourced"? (For example, it has been proposed that the procedures for requesting new and changed call letters in the Mass Media Bureau be privatized by contracting out the responsibility for maintaining the list of available call signs and processing call sign requests.)

Are there areas where private party self-certification or self-regulating organizations, overseen by the Commission, might replace advance Commission review and approval?

Should all forms and applications be routed through a single location for initial processing and/or database input?) Should the Commission allow parties to file comments via the Internet, on diskette, or require parties to include electronic mail or Internet addresses with their filings?)

How should the Commission expand its use of negotiated rulemakings, alternative dispute resolution, public meetings, forums, and roundtables?

What area(s) of FCC operations have serious problems with processing delays that result in significant unnecessary costs or other adverse impacts on regulated entities? What are some specific suggestions for alleviating such processing problems?

Do the Bureaus and Offices provide sufficient, meaningful, and useful information, in a timely fashion, concerning the status of applications, forms and other filings? How can we improve delivery of status information to the public?

How can we better meet customer service standards and goals? How could some changes be funded?

The Commission has denied the petition for reconsideration filed by the Idaho/Nevada/Utah State Conference of Branches of the NAACP, which argued that the failure of KDYL/KSFI-FM, Salt Lake City, UT, to implement an effective EEO program was evidence of discrimination which should be resolved in a hearing. The NAACP also contended that the licensee's arguments that its format and pay scales have affected the stations' ability to attract minority applicants reflect discriminatory intent.

The Commission found that the NAACP had not shown a material error of omission, or raised additional facts not previously known or existing and concluded there was no evidence of discrimination, and the licensee was correctly found to be qualified. The Commission also found that the licensee's explanation explanations as to its alleged obstacles with recruiting minority recruitment did not reflect discriminatory intent.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

A Spanish-language AM daytimer in East Providence, RI is fighting to stay on the air after dark, as it has for the past 12 years. Sighting a number of FCC blunders, it realized that it has no formal written authority from the Commission to keep the station on after sunset with 250 watts. WPMZ, East Providence has filed for Special Temporary Authority to keep the signal, claiming the Commission has given them plenty of verbal authority to do so, but never anything in writing. Crosstown Spanish competitor Cardwell Broadcasting is fighting the request, claiming the station should have realized the station had no night authority during due diligence when Bear Broadcasting bought the station in 1989.

ELSEWHERE

Norm Feuer's Triathlon Broadcasting is expanding its coverage by picking up two more stations in the Richland-Kennewick-Pasco, WA market, bringing its station count in that market to seven. It will buy CHR KIOK, Richland and news-talk KALE, Richland for \$1.2 million to combo with the other stations it is buying in that market, classic rock KEGX, Richland and news/talk KTCR, Kennewick. It is in an LMA with talk/sports KUJ and oldies KNLT, Walla Walla. After the deals are completed, Triathlon will own or operate 36 stations.

Triathlon is also picking up Southern Skies Corporations' station in Wichita and Little Rock to combo with its existing properties in those markets. Southern Skies will receive cash and stock for folding country stations KSSN, Little Rock and KMKV, Benton, AR, and KZSN-AM & FM Wichita/Hutchinson, KS into Triathlon's lair. The deal will give the company three AM's and three FM's in Wichita and three FM's in Little Rock.

Seattle's Fisher Broadcasting is buying radio stations in the Portland market to combo with its TV station there. Park Broadcasting's country combo of KWJJ-AM & FM will go to Fisher for \$35 million. Fisher owns KATU television in the market, 12 stations in Western Washington under Sunbrook Broadcasting, and KOMO-TV, talkers KVI and KOMO, and AC KPLZ, all Seattle.

Park is also dumping its Tallahassee stations. Country WNLS and talker WTNT will go to R. Sanders Hickey's WTNT, Inc. Purchase price is \$3.5 million. Hickey has an interest in Great South Broadcasting's (Southern Broadcasting) album rocker WTKX, Pensacola. Southern is picking up another FM in that market with its purchase of Sun Media's new rock outlet WOWW for \$2.6 million.

Colfax Communications is paying a whopping \$28 million for Par Broadcasting's oldies combo KOOL-AM & FM. Par recently bought the stations from Compass Radio Group. The stations will spin to Colfax at the same time the Compass/Par closing takes place. Colfax has duopolies in Washington, DC and Minneapolis.

A long-time LMA turns into an outright purchase this week in the Raleigh-Durham market as Pinnacle Broadcasting will buy Osborn's WFXK, Tarboro, NC for \$5.9 million. The deal will give Pinnacle a duopoly with urban AC WFXC and urban oldies WDUR, both Durham, NC. WFXK currently simulcasts WFXC.

Bruce Holberg's WOOD Radio is selling off its Grand Rapids, MI properties to Clear Channel Communications for \$42.25 million. Clear Channel will immediately LMA news-talker WOOD (AM), soft AC WOOD-FM and country WBCT, all licensed to Grand Rapids. The deal will bring Clear Channel's count to 47 radio stations in addition to its ten television stations.

Metropolitan Radio Group is picking up its second station, adult standards WEW, St. Louis for an undisclosed price from Alliance Broadcasting Co. Metropolitan owns sports outlet KCTE, Independence, MO (Kansas City).

Americom is buying up Reno with the purchase of three stations from New World Enterprises. News/sports KPLY, Sparks; Hot AC KQNV, Sparks; and album rocker KZAK, Reno are included in the deal for \$1.9 million cash. The stations are currently in a sales agreement with Americom. Americom is in the process of buying oldies KODS, Reno. No word on what will happen to Americom's LMA partner, progressive KTHX-FM, Carson City.

Tulsa sees a new duopoly with the transfer of jazz KTNT-FM, Edmond, OK from Life Broadcasting to Caribou Communications for \$2.65 million. Caribou owns heritage album rocker KATT-FM and hot AC KYIS, Oklahoma City.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

Prime Sports Radio's parent company Liberty Sports, Inc. is being sold to the chairman of the New Jersey Devils hockey team. Liberty's A-1 Television, PSR, and Fantasy Sports will go to the McMullen Group for an undisclosed price. It was a division of Tele-Communications, Inc., one of the nation's largest cable companies.

On the heels of the FCC's blessing, Disney has closed on its \$19 Billion purchase of Capital Cities/ABC. Capital Cities/ABC shareholders will receive one share of Disney stock and \$65 in cash for each of their shares.

The Radio Advertising Bureau reports record-breaking revenue increases for the last month of 1995. Revenues were up 8% to an estimated \$11.470 billion, up from \$10.652 billion during December, 1994. Local radio was up 9% while national was up 3% for the year. Network advertising was up 4% for the year. The Midwest and Southeast enjoyed ten percent local increases for the year while the East had the biggest national revenue jump for the year at six percent.

The alternative rock format is thriving, according to a new study just released by Interep's Exec. VP/Director of Research Marla Pirner. Based on just-released Simmons data, the number of stations in the format has tripled and share growth increased a full share point to 5.2. The study goes on to show that unlike album rock, alternative has equal appeal to both men and women, and listeners to the format index well above the norm in upper income brackets. M STREET BAZAAR. . . PEOPLE, PRODUCTS, AND PROGRAMMING

Rick Dees loves L.A., and has decided to stay there till the year 2000. He has signed a multi-year contract with Gannett's KIIS-AM & FM to do the "Rick Dees in the Morning" show. Dees has been with KIIS since 1981.

The Contemporary Christian Morningstar Radio Network has made a couple of appointments. Rich Tiner will focus on "broadening the Christian Radio involvement" as VP/Operations and Programming. Tom Carter assumes the PD role for the network's "Today's Christian Music" format. Mike Miller will add general management and administrative responsibilities to his VP role.

ABC Radio and Court TV have renewed their agreement to provide court coverage to ABC Radio affiliates. Affiliates can pick up several features, including the news program, "Court TV Legal Minute," a daily 60-second report on the law. The service also provides courtroom audio clips, interviews, live courtroom audio, and anchored coverage of major trial events. The two companies are also developing a radio feature for kids. ABC Radio's Urban Gold format is adding two new features to its line-up. "The Solid Gold Soul Entertainment Report" is a 60 to 90 second update on celebrities, movies, and music, along with other interesting entertainment facts. "Where Are They Now" is also 60 to 90 seconds on the stars and celebrities of yesterday. Both features will air on Fridays, once during each on-air shift.

USA Radio Network has added a new feature, "The Busy Woman's Time Savings Tips" stressing time management issues for women "whose lives don't end when they leave the office." For more info, call (800) 829-8111.

Boston-based Superadio debuts the "John & Judy Morning Show" hosted by John Garabedian and Judy Paparelli. Garabedian is the host of the syndicated show "House Party." The new show uses "cross-platform" technology that allows the local station to program its own music and local elements. For more info, call (508) 626-2000.

TFT, Inc.'s new Emergency Alerting System equipment, "EAS 911 Encoder/Decoder," has been granted type certification by the FCC. The new system features shorter attention signals and the ability to route emergency information to specific areas. It can also turn on specially equipped receivers in the event of an emergency.

OUT WITH THE OLD, IN WITH THE NEW. . . . The Commission has drafted an "Implementation Schedule" for the Telecommunications Act of 1996. For issues affecting radio, the timeline speculates that the Commission should have most Rule Making Proposals issued by the third quarter of this year. The new radio ownership rules are already in effect. The FCC's Order will make them official in March. The new ownership rules will be reviewed every two years.

Here's a little known fact out of the new rules: If your station stays silent for an entire year, its license will expire at the end of that one year period. The Commission hopes to clear out some of the dead wood this way. Also, many minor changes to radio stations may not need a permit soon. The rulemaking proposal should be out between April and June of this year.

JONES SET TO ROCK. . . . Jones Satellite Networks is launching a new "rock alternative" format. The format will focus on "familiar" alternative rock from the late 70's, 80's, and 90's. It's architect is Paragon Research's Mike Henry who helped build Denver's KXPK, "The Peak." Core artists include U2, Talking Heads, Gin Blossoms, Annie Lennox, and Hootie and the Blowfish, to name a few.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Entercom's bid for upgrading KNRK, Camas, WA from a class C3 to a class C2 is over after the Commission dismissed its application as unacceptable for filing. KNRK had asked the FCC to waive short-spacing rules to allow it to upgrade from its existing transmitter site. The Commission denied the request because Entercom asked to revisit the contour protection rule, which was adopted in part to eliminate the inefficiencies of the old spacing process. In its decision, the Commission wrote, "In these times of shrinking government resources, it is not an efficient use of the Commission's limited staff resources to allow new filings based on an inherently inefficient spacing waiver process. . . With the Audio Services Division currently processing in excess of 1,000 FM construction permit applications per year, and with these applications steadily increasing in difficulty as the FM band fills up, we see no justification in needlessly complicating and slowing the application process for substandard operations."

Wolpin Broadcasting's WCAR, Livonia, MI was able to successfully shed itself of a costly antenna monitor after it filed to augment its nighttime directional pattern. Beasley's KAAV, Little Rock alleged WCAR's changes would cause objectionable interference to the station, so the Commission required WCAR to install approx. \$21,500 worth of monitoring equipment to ensure stability of its critical array. WCAR appealed citing its years of technical compliance and arguing that the changes have nothing to do with its stability and will only affect its radiation patterns. The FCC agreed and dropped the requirement.

It's renewal time for AM, FM, and FM translator stations in Michigan and Ohio and FM translators in Utah. Sometime in mid-March, the FCC will be mailing renewal booklets to these stations. To check to make sure your address is current with the Commission, call Claudia Patterson at (202) 418-2784 or fax your correction to (202) 418-1411 by March 8.

ELSEWHERE

A three-way deal in Florida will yield a duopoly partner for OmniAmerica in the Orlando market. Urban WJHM, Daytona Beach will go from Beasley to OmniAmerica, which already owns CHR WXXL, Orlando, for \$21.3 million. The deal is part of a three-way simultaneous transaction that nets Beasley sports talk WQAM, Miami and country WKIS, Boca Raton (Miami) from Sunshine Wireless for \$57 million. Beasley already owns dance-CHR WPOW, Miami. The Orlando LMA will begin within the next three weeks. An LMA will also happen soon in Miami.

Elsewhere in Florida, Commodore Media ups its count in the Ft. Pierce-Stuart market to six as it will purchase country WKQS, Gifford, country WAVW, Vero Beach and adult standards WAXE, Vero Beach from Media VI for an undisclosed price. Commodore already owns rocker WZZR, Stuart and oldies WQOL, Vero Beach. It currently has a sales agreement with country WPAW, Vero Beach, as well.

American Radio Systems bought up the Lincoln Group's properties in Rochester, NY. Lincoln's news-talkers WHAM and WHTK, CHR WPXY-FM, and AC WVOR-FM will combo with sports WCMF-AM, rocker WCMF-FM, and soft AC WRMM for a price tag just over of \$30 million.

Osborn Communications is doubling up in Wheeling with the purchase of WKWK for \$2.65 million. Osborn owns country WOVK and country/religion WWVA there. The LMA begins immediately. Osborn had also recently announced the purchase of soft AC WHLX, Bethlehem, WV

Jim Ingstad is working on his collection in North Dakota by purchasing Brill Media's sports KQFN, West Fargo, ND and rocker KQWB-FM, Moorhead, MN in the Fargo market for \$2 million. The combo is Jim Ingstad's first in Fargo. His brother Tom owns KLTA and KPFX.

In the Charleston, West Virginia market, Ardman Broadcasting's duopoly is going to Bristol Broadcasting for \$2.8 million. Ardman has sports WWSR-AM, CHR WWSR-FM and country WBES, Dunbar, WV which will combo with talker WQBE and country WQBE-FM.

Fairbanks Communications is buying up two more stations in West Palm Beach, bringing its total there to six. Ardman Broadcasting will let country WCLB-FM, and sports outlet WIRA, Ft. Pierce go for \$23 million. The stations had been in a sales agreement with Fairbanks.

Infinity Broadcasting's first foray outside of the radio business should bolster its presence in its radio markets. It paid \$300 million for TDI Worldwide, an outdoor ad firm that handles billboards, bus sides, and other media in most of the markets where Infinity owns radio properties. According to Inside Radio, TDI also has the exclusive advertising rights in the London underground and 4,000 London buses.

TM Century is stepping into the bartered syndication world. It has reached an agreement with Multiverse Networks to handle the advertising sales time for the TM Comedy Network. The barter arrangement will begin immediately. Multiverse also handles ad sales for Dr. Laura Schlesinger and Ken Hamblin.

Jones Satellite is upping its presence at the Country Radio Seminar this year. Lorianne Crook and Charlie Chase, hosts of the Crook & Chase Country Countdown will be at the Jones booth (#807-809) from 1:30 to 2:30 Thursday and Friday. Jones' two country formats, CD Country and U.S. Country will be broadcast live from the show with almost three dozen country artist interviews scheduled over three days.

TM Century's Ultimate Digital Studio is now compatible with Broadcast Electronics' AudioVault 100, giving TM access to BE customers who want to use TM's hardware and software. In the same breath, TM has also completed an RBDS interface that allows broadcasters to broadcast artist/title information and station ID's on the data stream RBDS utilizes. RBDS allows stations to broadcast data and text messages to specially equipped radios. For more info, call TM at (214) 247-8850.

National Public Radio is opening up its state-of-the-art Washington, DC studios to the public. Studio 4A offers digital and analog studios, recording facilities, CD mastering, and tape and record restoration. For a fee schedule and availability, call (202) 414-2482.

Group W Radio's VP/Controller Wesley Spencer will move over to take on the task at newly-acquired CBS Radio. He had been handling the job for Group W since 1986.

Jones' FM Lite format has a new operations manager. Steve Hibbard, who built the format when he was at Drake-Chenault before Jones purchased the company, will return after being PD at WNWV, Cleveland.

Most public radio listeners don't mind "enhanced" commercial activity on Corporation for Public Broadcasting-funded stations. A survey just completed for the CPB by SRI International shows sales of audio tapes, paid PSA's, on-line services, and commercial spot announcements are appropriate methods for generating revenues. The only two activities to get less than favorable responses were the promotion of home shopping services or charity bingo television programs. Most public radio listeners said enhanced sponsorship announcements would not affect their likelihood to contribute to their favorite station, however, 22% said it would be a factor. 87% of radio members said enhanced spots are okay because of federal funding shortfalls.

Clear Channel Communications buys Ardman Broadcasting Corporation's new rock WENZ in Cleveland for \$6 million. Clear Channel has had a Sales Marketing agreement with the station for some time and also owns news-talker WERE and rocker WNCX in the market.

In Miami, Paxson Communications Corporation has agreed to acquire Spanish hits WXDJ, Homestead and Spanish AC WRMA, Ft. Lauderdale from New Age Broadcasting, Inc. Purchase price for the stations is approximately \$115 million. Paxson already owns smooth jazz WLVE and rock WZTA, Miami Beach; news/sports WINZ, Miami; and talker WFTL, Ft. Lauderdale.
