RADIO DISNEY EARNS ITS EARS . . . ABC Radio Networks is moving forward with plans of a national rollout of its "Radio Disney" 24-hour children's format. ABC describes the format as a top-40 style playlist that includes pop hits, novelty oldies, TV and movie soundtracks, and kids' songs. Interspersed are several short-form features each hour, including ABC News for Kids, ESPN Sports for Kids, Kid of the Week, and on-air call-ins. ABC has been testing the format on four AM stations--KCNR, Salt Lake City; KDIZ, Golden Valley, MN (Minneapolis); WKHX, Atlanta; and WYDE, Birmingham. KKDZ, Seattle recently picked up the format after the Seattle-based Kidstar Network folded.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Renewals of license for several AM stations were canceled this week. Robert S. Cannella's WKRU in Burnettsville, SC; Lyn-Win Broadcasting, Inc.'s WTRQ in Warsaw, NC; Wilkes-Posey Broadcasting, Inc.'s WJZS in Orangeburg, SC; Russell Communications' WKXS in Marion, SC; Stanley Broadcasting System, Inc.'s WTXY in Whiteville, NC; and WGSW, Inc.'s WLMA in Greenwood, SC. WTXY and WLMA are currently on the air and the owners are working to get their licenses reinstated.

WVGO License, LP, former licensee of WBZU in Richmond, VA petitioned the Commission to reduce a fine of \$10,000 issued on Oct. 15, 1996 for broadcasting indecent material on the "Howard Stern Show". The fine was reduced to \$6,000 because "prior to the issuance of the forfeiture and on its own initiative, the licensee acknowledged and corrected potential problems with its programming."

The Commission denied a petition filed by the Rainbow PUSH Coalition, and granted the renewal of license for Nelson Enterprises, Inc.'s WSPY-FM in Plano, IL. Rainbow claims the licensee did not make adequate efforts to recruit minorities from urban areas within the Metropolitan Statistical Area, including Aurora, Joliet and Chicago, IL.

The National Rainbow Coalition and Operation PUSH also filed petitions against renewals of MyStar Communication Corp.'s WMYS and WTPI in Indianapolis and WZPL in Greenfield, IN. The Commission found no evidence of employment discrimination but faults the licensee with deficient EEO efforts with respect to minorities and the licensee failed to record the race or ethnic origin and/or recruitment source for more than 60% of its applicants. A Notice of Apparent Liability was issued to MyStar for \$12,000 and reporting conditions imposed on the stations through 1999.

KEGL, Ft. Worth, TX keeps its license but not its money after an FCC ruling this week. The Commission denied an informal objection filed by the National Black Media Coalition and petitions to deny filed by the NAACP, Tom Blackwell and Al Westcott, which alleged EEO violations. The Commission found that there were no questions of fact warranting designation for hearing and no evidence of discrimination but, the licensee's recruitment efforts were deemed deficient. The station was granted a short-term renewal with reporting conditions and issued a Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture in the amount of \$18,750. Eagle tried to get some of the fine returned through a Petition for Declaratory Ruling, which was denied because Eagle is not entitled to a refund, even if the basis upon which that claim is levied is later found to be invalid. The Petitions for Reconsideration that were filed by all parties were dismissed.

Waiver of the Commission's one-to-a-market rule was granted to allow Sinclair Radio of St. Louis common ownership and operation of KDNL-TV, WVRV in East St. Louis, IL and KPNT in Ste. Genevieve, MO. Assignment of license applications were granted for KDNL-TV from River City License Partnership to KDNL Licensee, Inc. and for WVRV and KPNT from River City to Sinclair Radio of St. Louis Licensee, Inc.

Near the middle of May, the Commission will be sending out renewal booklets to licensees containing all the information necessary to renew the licenses of radio stations (AM/FM/FM translators) in Kansas and Nebraska and translators only in California. Corrections should be submitted no later than May 12. For further information, please contact Claudia Patterson at (202) 418-2784.

ELSEWHERE

Westwood One will drop the radio-only broadcast portion of the Late Late Radio Show with Steve Mason and Tom Snyder effective June 2. The CBS TV simulcast with Tom Snyder will still be available. Steve Mason will remain under contract with CBS until the end of 1997.

Clear Channel Communications extends its international reach by purchasing Radio Bonton, an FM on 99.7 MHz in Prague, Czech Republic, for \$1 million cash. Clear Channel intends to partner with Bonton to expand over Eastern Europe. Clear Channel also has radio holdings in Australia and New Zealand.

Mortenson Broadcasting is buying into the Washington, DC market, picking up WNTL (AM), Indian Head, MD for \$1.5 million cash. WNTL is operated by trustee Merrill Cohen. The station has been in an LMA with Radio Broadcast Communications' WINX-FM, and is simulcasting the oldies format. Bruce Houston of Blackburn & Company was the broker.

Patterson Broadcasting is buying two more stations in Fresno, bringing its total there to five. It will buy Radio Dinuba's religion KRDU and soft AC KJOI, both Dinuba, to combo with rock KRZR, Hanford; sports KCBL; and dance KBOS, Tulare. It's also picking up another in Grand Rapids to combo with soft AC WLHT, country WRCV, and new rock WGRD. William E. Kuiper, Jr.'s jazz WQFN, Walker, MI will change hands soon. No terms on either deal were disclosed. Plans are to switch the format to some kind of AC. Kuiper will keep his religion combo, WFUR-AM & FM.

Wilks Broadcast Acquisitions is selling off its four station combo in Augusta, GA, to Bill Bungeroth's Cumulus Media, L.L.C. for \$15.5 million. Jeff Wilks will stay on with Cumulus. The four are classic rock combo WEKL and WGUS, North Augusta, GA; country WUUS, Martinez, GA; and rock WRXR-FM, Aiken, SC.

Great Scott Broadcasting will make \$20 million on its sale of news and sports WMBO and modern AC WPCX, Auburn, NY to Salt City Communications, Inc. WPCX serves the Syracuse market. Dan Gammon of Americom brokered the deal.

The University of the District of Columbia is putting its FM station on the block. Jazz WDCU, at 90.1 MHz, is licensed to Washington, DC. Blackburn & Company will handle the details and hopes to have the station sold by the first week of June.

Another non-commercial station is on the block. It's the Flint (Mich.) Board of Education's classical/jazz WFBE, a 50,000 watt class B, which is licensed on the commercial band at 95.7 MHz. Blackburn is also handling this sale. The school station is willing to swap facilities or enter an LMA, as well.

Jacor Communications will offer 5.3 million shares of common stock to build up its warchest. Approximately 4.6 million will be offered to the public. Zell/Chilmark Fund, L.P., Jacor's largest shareholder, will purchase at least \$20 million of Jacor common shares. Donaldson, Lufkin, & Jenrette Securities Corp. will be the lead underwriter.

Clarifications: Last week, Crawford Broadcasting announced it will buy WLLZ, Detroit from Greater Media. We should have stated John L. Pierce of Force Communications was the broker for the buyer and apologize for the oversight. We also reported that WGAB-FM, Newburgh, IN (Evansville) has entered into an LMA-to-buy with Connoisseur Communications classic hits WTRI-FM, Mount Carmel, IL. The relationship is an LMA only; there is no purchase option.

Strategic Media Research has signed a sales representation agreement with Premiere Radio Networks. Under the terms of the agreement, Premiere's sales agents will have the exclusive rights to distribute AccuTrack, Strategic Media Research's newly introduced programming and market tracking product. The service tracks ten key perceptual images for management to profile themselves and key competitors. Marketing awareness is tracked continuously and reported weekly and monthly.

Radio Music License Committee Chairman Randy Bongarten is appealing to radio stations for their support in the Committee's negotiations with BMI. The RMLC and ASCAP completed negotiations last year. RMLC is asking that stations authorize the Committee to represent them, and send money to help fund the negotiations. Bongarten is asking for \$100 from stations with revenue less than \$150,000; \$200 for those between \$150,000 and \$500,000; and \$350 from those over \$500,000. United Stations Talk Radio Networks announced the expansion of its weekend program schedule, by launching "The Charles DeRose Financial Advisor" program. The three-hour, interactive show allows listeners to phone in with their questions on investment and finance. A NEW DIRECTION FOR IN-BAND DAB. . . DAB developers USA Digital Radio and Lucent Technologies' Bell Labs are teaming up to develop a single digital audio broadcasting technology. The two companies have been competing to bring a standard technology to in-band on-channel DAB. The joint effort encompasses both AM and FM signals and switches the technological focus of the project to Perceptual Audio Coding (PAC), a mathematical version of how humans hear sound. Bell Labs holds the patent on PAC. USA Digital is a partnership between Westinghouse/CBS and Gannett.

MARTZ CONTINUES REGIONAL GROWTH. . . The Martz Communications Group will soon be five stations larger. In two separate agreements, its buying AC WICY and country WVNK, Malone, NY, from L.C.C. Media and talk WMIQ and rock WIMK, Iron Mountain, MI and rock WUPK, Marquette, MI from Superior Media Group. The Commission canceled the license of silent station WAZF in Yazoo City, MS, owned by Michael Augustus. The station's license renewal was returned in October per fee section.

A Petition for Reconsideration of a previously dismissed counterproposal, filed by Twenty One Sound Communications, regarding FM allotments in Lincoln, Osage Beach, Steelville and Warsaw, MO was dismissed as repetitious by the Commission. The counterproposal was originally dismissed because it did not include affidavits verifying the statements in the proposal.

Jac-Vin Religious Broadcasters' WJTD in McArthur, OH changed to non-commercial status this week. The station is at 98.7 MHz.

FCC Chairman Reed Hundt announced that his Chief Counsel, Julius Genachowski is leaving the Commission. Upon Genachowski's departure, Gretchen Rubin will become Counsel to the Chairman. Rubin came to the Commission in 1995 as Special Advisor to Mass Media Bureau Chief Roy Stewart.

ELSEWHERE

Mortenson Broadcasting is buying up two more stations this week. It's filed an application to buy Special Markets Media, Inc.'s urban/gospel WLLE, Raleigh, NC for an undisclosed price. In Kentucky, it will buy country WCAK, Carlisle, KY from James P. Gray for \$450,000. Mortenson owns religion combo WJMM-FM, Versailles and WCGW, Nicholasville, KY in the Lexington market and recently announced plans to buy oldies WNTL, Indian Head, MD, which serves Washington, DC.

Zimmer Broadcasting will spend \$10.8 million for Big Mack Broadcasting's four station combo in Joplin. The deal includes AC KJMK and classic rock KXDG, Webb City, MO; and country KIXQ and CHR KSYN, Joplin.

Children's Broadcasting's Radio AAHS children's network has created a partnership with New Jersey's Liberty Science Center to build an AAHS World Radio studio on it's property at Liberty State Park in Jersey City. Liberty Science Center is a not-for-profit institution devoted to informal science and technology education through interactive exploration.

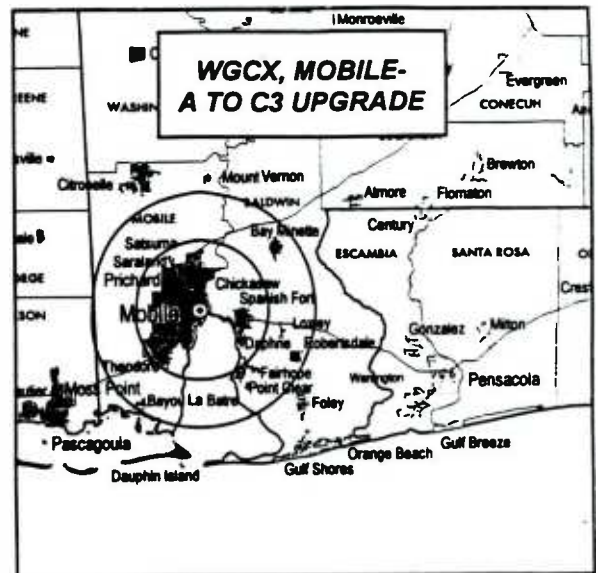
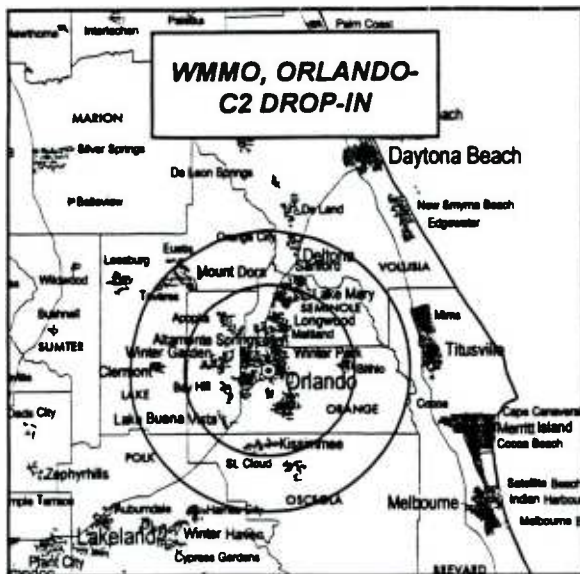

JACKSON STONEWALLS VIACOM. . . . Jesse Jackson's Rainbow-PUSH Coalition has formally asked the FCC to block Viacom's sale of its four Washington, D.C. stations to Evergreen, alleging that Viacom reneged on its 1993 promise to find minority buyers. The Reverend Jackson is concerned about what he sees as the declining percentage of minority-owned broadcast licenses. Jackson followed up his initial FCC filing with a pledge to buy stock in several publicly-held media corporations, to "use our leverage as a stockholder to promote equal opportunity." The Washington Post originally reported the Rainbow-PUSH challenge, along with Jackson's charge that Viacom reneged on its 1993 promise to sell some stations to minority buyers. Here's Jackson's quote: "The FCC has basically waved as the ship of monopoly has gone down the river." So it sounds as if Jackson is waging a crusade that's larger than just the Viacom/Evergreen/Chancellor situation in Washington.

EMMIS TO JAZZ UP ITS NEW YORK PORTFOLIO. . . . Tribune trades WQCD, New York to Emmis -- for a player to be named later and a chance to dodge the taxman. The \$150 million-or-so deal begins with a management agreement for "up to three years." During that time, Emmis will manage the successful smooth jazz FM while Tribune looks for a property that Emmis could buy and then swap to Tribune. It sounds complicated, but otherwise Tribune gets socked for taxes big-time on a property it's owned for many years. Emmis already owns urban AC WRKS-FM and hip-hop WQHT in Gotham.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

WDOD of Chattanooga, Inc. has been ordered to pay an \$11,000 forfeiture for failure to recruit for all openings and maintain adequate records for meaningful self-assessment of its EEO program at WDOD AM/FM. Reporting conditions were also imposed on the stations through the year 2000 as a result of a petition to deny the license renewal applications filed by the National Rainbow Coalition. The station's renewal applications were granted.

Several stations submitted applications to the Commission for expanded band frequencies this week. Radio Property Ventures, licensee of KQXI in Arvada, CO applied for 1690 KHz and KPHP Radio, Inc., licensee of KKSL in Lake Oswego, OR applied for 1640 KHz.

Evangelistic Alaska Missionary Fellowship's KJNP in North Pole, AK was granted a modification of license to operate as a non-commercial educational station. The station is on 1170 KHz.

The license to cover for Boswell Broadcasting Company's WLIN in Durant, MS was returned by the Commission. The attorney for WLIN said they had sent in the incorrect fee. The license to cover has subsequently been issued.

The license for Bonneville Holding Company's KLDE in Houston to operate its former main facility as an auxiliary was canceled by the Commission per applicant's request.

ELSEWHERE

ARS is picking up its third Boston AM with the \$4.5 million purchase of WNFT from Greater Media. There may be an LMA prior to closing on the 1150 KHz frequency, though American Radio hasn't confirmed that or its future format plans. The onetime children's station is now simulcasting country WKLB-FM. ARS may be looking at a signal upgrade, along with the possibility of using the station to carry overflow play-by-play from all-sports WEEI. But there's no official new format yet. ARS also owns talker WRKO there. Greater Media also just shed its AM in Detroit, WLLZ, to Mortenson. Glenn Serafin brokered the Boston deal.

Fuller-Jeffrey adds muscle to its New England base with ADD Radio Group's WSTG, Hampton, NH. Regional executive Marty Lessard starts an immediate LMA with the station that's got a colorful name: "The Stage at 102.1 FM." But Fuller-Jeffrey's pointedly not making a commitment to the current pop music format. Fuller-Jeffrey's Southern New Hampshire cluster includes country simulcast WOKQ, Dover NH/WPKQ, Berlin NH and classic rock WXBB, Kittery, ME.

Who's listening to AM? A new Eastman study finds that 40% of the population listens to at least some AM radio during the week. Among author Charlie Sislen's other conclusions: AM radio's audience is "primarily composed of upscale adults, 54% of whom are between the ages of 25-54, with a cume audience composition centering on the 35+ segment of the population." He says duopoly and an aging population should be favorable for AM. Surprise finding: AM finishes lower in cities where a great deal of the population grew up elsewhere, such as some cities in the Southeast -- fast-growing markets with a transient population. AM fares better in markets like Milwaukee with a stable population base. For a copy of the story called, "AM Radio Shows Strong Audience Appeal," call Sislen at (212) 424-6417.

Arbitron hopes it's finally shaken off Pretesting Company's legal challenge to its Personal Portable Meter technology. But that doesn't mean the U.S. is going to see future diarykeepers clip on their shiny new PPMs any time soon: The system is much more likely to debut overseas, where there's keen interest in high-tech audience measurement. Arbitron reports enthusiastic response there, gauging from appearances at several recent European exhibitions. And now it may feel free to let 'er rip, based on last week's Circuit Court of Appeals ruling in favor of Arbitron. Arbitron debuted the PPM project in 1992; Pretesting filed a patent infringement suit a year later. Last August a federal district court returned a summary judgment for Arbitron, now affirmed by a three-judge panel of the U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals in New York. Arbitron says it's moving to collect court costs from Pretesting. The Holy Grail of passive-metering technology is the promise that it should be able to measure usage of both radio and TV.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

It's Yankee pinstripes for Interep's Allied Radio Partners: The rep firm will be selling the in-game spots for both the New York Yankees Radio Network and flagship WABC, New York, thanks to a deal with radio rightsholder Madison Square Garden Network. MSG got the play-by-play rights earlier this year after the Yanks and WABC ended their sometimes-stormy relationship. WABC listeners probably didn't notice the changeover to MSG: last year's booth team of John Sterling and Michael Kay is still calling the action. But while the Yankees are battling the rest of the American League, Allied will be competing with Katz. That's because Katz-owned Amcast reps WABC -- whose inventory includes the pre- and post-game baseball spots.

CANADA THIS WEEK

In a move that may lead to the launch of CHR formats on FM, the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) has removed restrictions on the number of "hit" records FM stations may play. The CRTC defines "hit" records as those which, when new, achieved popular success as measured on a number of Canadian music industry charts. The new policy applies only to records which charted after 1980. Limits on airplay of "hits" from earlier years remain in place to protect AM oldies and adult standards stations from FM competition. The new ruling excludes FM stations in the Montreal and Ottawa/Hull markets. The CRTC and broadcasters agreed that removal of "hit" restrictions on English language broadcasters in these markets would harm competing French language outlets which are required to program a fixed percentage of French recordings.

M STREET BAZAAR. . . PEOPLE, PRODUCTS, AND PROGRAMMING

The newest Westwood feature is "Today's Health Minute", a one-minute daily feature that's produced by Time, Inc.'s Health magazine. Syndicator Westwood One will also include "Today's Health Minute" in its "America in the Morning" wakeup show.

But can he shovel the snow in Minnesota? Former NPR News Division VP Bill Buzenberg will become Senior Director of News and Information for Minnesota Public Radio. He's currently on leave from National Public Radio to finish a book project, and will start serving MPR as a consultant in July and assume full-time responsibilities in January '98. Bill Kling is president of MPR, and Dennis Hamilton is VP/Broadcasting. The Minnesota Public Radio empire includes anchor station KNOW-FM in the Twin Cities as the centerpiece of a 30-station network in Minnesota and surrounding areas. Buzenberg will also have responsibility for the news coverage on MPR-owned classical stations.

Seth Kaufman joins SportsFan Radio Network as Manager of Affiliate Relations, based in the syndicator's New York offices. Kaufman's been an account executive/regional market specialist at the D&R Radio rep. Rob Scolaro is SportsFan's Director of Affiliate Relations. Also at WinStar-owned Sportsfan: It just finished wiring up its New York studio, for East coast program origination.

YOU CAN'T TELL THE COMMISSIONERS WITHOUT A PROGRAM . . . Chairman Reed Hundt's leaving a year early, as soon as President Clinton can replace him. Commissioner Jim Quello will leave the seat he's held since 1974 and likely be replaced by current FCC General Counsel Bill Kennard. And Commissioner Rachelle Chong will likely be replaced by Senate staffer Harold Furchtgott-Roth in one of the two Republican seats. That leaves Commissioner Susan Ness as the lone holdover. Hundt says he'll stay on until a replacement is found. But he's not revealing his plans, beyond saying he wants to spend more time with his three kids and he wants to finish writing a novel about student life at Yale, and might write a book about telecommunications reform. The longtime friend of Al Gore worked at the Latham and Watkins law firm before accepting Clinton's offer to chair the FCC in 1993.

OCEAN FRONT PROPERTY . . . It was inevitable that Florida radio tycoon Bud Paxson would finally buy beachfront radio property in his new headquarters market of West Palm Beach, and now it's happened. Paxson Communications will acquire four stations from American Radio Systems: oldies WOLL, Riviera Beach; classic rock WKGR, Ft. Pierce; and talk WBZT and news-formatted WEAT-AM, both West Palm Beach. The group relocated from the Tampa Bay area to West Palm Beach a couple of years ago, but didn't own any stations there. Paxson has been on a furious TV buying spree since last month's fortuitous Supreme Court ruling on must-carry -- so the \$33 million pickup of the four ARS stations is a surprise entry in the "radio" column. Paxson's also acquiring a communications antenna tower in Ft. Pierce. The M Street database now shows Paxson owning 47 stations overall, 43 just in Florida. Blackburn & Company brokered the transaction between Paxson and American Radio. ARS says once the sale to Paxson is completed, it will own country WIRK-FM, soft AC WEAT-FM and expects to exercise options to purchase new rock WPBZ, Indiantown and hot AC WMBX, Jensen Beach.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Never mind "Where's Waldo" -- where's the public file? The FCC is opening the whole question of whether to relax the main studio and public inspection file rules, and the outcome may significantly help local group operators reduce costs. But it may irritate community leaders and cut the last ties between a station and its immediate community of license. As it is now, many stations actually maintain two sets of public files -- one at a location in the city of license, and the other at their studio. Among the Commission's possible options: allowing operators to locate a main studio "within the principal community of any station licensed to its community of license." Or allowing a station to locate a main studio within a radius of a set number of miles from the center of its community of license. Or a combination of the two. As for public files, the FCC is seeking comments on proposals like allowing them to be located wherever the main studio is, and possible ways to "clarify and streamline" requirements about what goes in the file. The Notice of Proposed Rulemaking is MM Docket No. 97-138.

Another EEO-related fine: Renda Broadcasting Corp.'s WJAS and WSHH in Pittsburgh, PA were denied a reduction of a \$16,500 forfeiture by the Commission. The Commission continues to focus on the EEO process, as well as the actual hiring results.

A petition for reconsideration in the case of a Citrus Heights, CA CP filed by Kin Shaw Wong was denied by the Commission. Wong requested reconsideration of a dismissed application for an extension of time for unbuilt station KPTO and cancellation of the CP, as well as modification of the facilities and assignment of the license to Rene de la Rosa, which was dismissed.

The Commission denied an Application for Review filed by the Educational Information Corporation, licensee of WCPE in Raleigh, NC. It contested the denial of its request for a waiver to overlap the protected 60 dBu service contour of WXYC (FM), Chapel Hill, NC and related amendment. FCC claims EIC's application, as initially submitted and granted, demonstrates that EIC can expand service substantially without causing prohibited overlap, and the amendment reflects an interest in avoiding the added cost of a directional antenna to extend its signal without creating new prohibited overlap.

QueenB Radio, Inc. was granted a temporary conditional waiver of the one-to-a-market rule to permit common ownership of stations standards KKPL, Opportunity, WA along with Spokane stations sports KTRW, news/talk KXLY, dance KZZU-FM, soft AC KXLY-FM and KXLY-TV. QueenB was also granted assignment of license for KPPL from Concrete River Associates, LP. The waiver grant, however, is subject to the outcome of the pending television ownership rulemaking proceeding.

Sock Hop Radio AM 950, Inc., licensee of KDSX, Denison, TX, has applied for a new expanded band AM station on 1700 KHz.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

Mania Klenburd Baghdadi has been appointed Assistant Chief (Law) of the Policy and Rules Division, Mass Media Bureau. Baghdadi joined the Commission in 1994 and has worked on the digital television and broadcast attribution proceedings, among other matters.

ELSEWHERE

ARS is a seller in West Palm Beach, but a buyer in Portsmouth, NH: It's paying about \$6 million to acquire four stations from Precision Media. They are CHR WERZ, Exeter; adult progressive WSRI, Rochester, NH; plus adult standards-programmed WMYF, Exeter and WZNN, Rochester. The coastal New Hampshire market is just north of the American Radio hometown of Boston.

Cox -- which picked up Birmingham country combo WZZK-AM/FM and oldies WODL in the NewCity merger -- is dramatically expanding its beachhead there, in two separate deals. It's acquiring urban contemporary WENN and black gospel WAGG from Booker T. Washington Broadcasting Services, and recent rating successes urban contemporary WBHJ, Tuscaloosa and urban AC WBHK, Warrior from H&P Radio LLC.

New Wave becomes a group again, with its \$5.3 million purchase of three stations in the Monterey Bay-Salinas market: smooth jazz KXDC, Carmel, country/progressive hybrid KPIG, Freedom and modern AC KCDU, Hollister. Seller is Nevada-based Elettra Broadcasting, which has no other broadcast interests. Jon Ferrari and Charles Cohn are the principals of New Wave Broadcasting, which now owns three stations in El Paso. The SMA with classical KBOQ, Carmel will continue. Kalil & Company brokered.

Capstar is doubling the number of stations it owns in Huntsville through its Capstar Acquisition Company. Frank Osborn-led Southern Star is buying WWXQ, Trinity; WQXW, Meridianville; and WTAK-FM, Hartselle from Griffith Broadcasting for \$5.45 million. The buyer now owns country trimulcast WDRM, Decatur; and WBHP and WHOS, Huntsville, in the northern Alabama market.

Phil Giordano's April Broadcasting extends its demographic reach to older African-American adults in the Mobile market by acquiring urban adult WDLT, Chickasaw from Tom Wilson's United Broadcasting. April already owns urban contemporary WBLX there.

More "Flush Rush" and a return to the Fairness Doctrine? Rush Limbaugh is the target villain of a new mass mailing by the National Organization for Women, which includes a suggested protest letter to FCC Chairman Reed Hundt. NOW denounces Limbaugh for using the "power of the public airwaves to mobilize anti-feminist, racist and homophobic sentiment. While NOW has even refused the opportunity to purchase airtime, Limbaugh's advertisers subsidize his hostile, right-wing demagoguery." NOW reminds people of its campaign to get the Florida orange juice folks to drop their ads on Rush's show, and says Phase 2 of its anti-Rush campaign is "demanding equal time on the airwaves." It says that might include going to Congress to reinstate the Fairness Doctrine. Memo to NOW: Rush's TV show is no longer in syndication, so you can take out the line about "hundreds of radio and TV stations" beaming Rush's "bigotry and intolerance to millions of people."

Correction to a detail in last week's story about Greater Media: It sold its WLLZ, Monroe (Detroit) to Crawford Broadcasting -- not Mortenson Broadcasting.

So far, no indications from Black Rock that Karmazin will change his current reporting setup for the various CBS radio operations that he manages.

NPR hires veteran Canadian Broadcasting Corporation news executive Jeffrey Dvorkin as its new Acting VP of News and Information. His appointment is subject to approval by the National Public Radio board of directors, which meets July 23-24.

Eastman Radio VP/Marketing and Research Charlie Sislen joins Research Director, Inc. after 12 years with the Katz-owned rep firm. Sislen worked with RDI's Rhody Bosley, Marc Greenspan and Julie Heath at Arbitron before his career at Katz, and joins Research Director as a partner. Each of the Katz-owned rep firms has its own research chief. No replacement yet for Sislen at Eastman.

Digital Generation Systems has just hired Columbine/JDS executive Bob Howard as its new Vice President of Sales. He'd been VP of agency and rep systems at Columbine/JDS based in New York. DG Systems is in the business of providing electronic delivery of commercials and programming to both radio and TV stations.

Tom Dine replaces Kevin Klose as President of Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty, beginning August 1. Dine has been working at the U.S. Agency for International Development, ran the American Israel Public Affairs Committee for 13 years before that and was a foreign policy advisor to Senator Ted Kennedy.

Dick Morris hits the talkshow circuit again: The famous Clinton advisor was a pinch-hitting featured speaker at the R&R talk convention in Washington, D.C. a couple of months ago. Now he's got more time to prepare his act, as the National Association of Radio Talk Show Hosts books him for its annual convention this summer.
