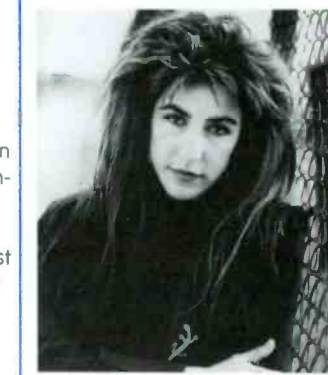
### ACOUSTIC ALCHEMY

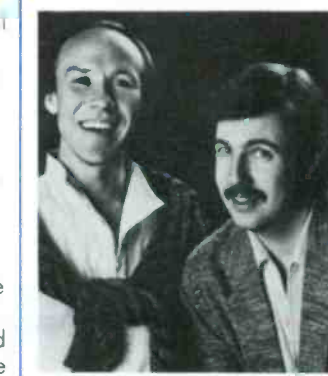
