



In August 1946, CJBQ went on the air for the first time, with a 250 watt transmitter located on Maitland Drive in Belleville. Today, forty years later, CJBQ is heard throughout East Central Ontario from its six tower array and 10,000 watt transmitter at Hillier Township in Prince Edward County. The station's studios were originally located in a small building at 11 Victoria Avenue in Belleville. Just 12 months ago, CJBQ moved to its glamorous new studios and offices at 10 South Front Street, overlooking the beautiful Bay of Quinte. The studios are equipped with the latest state-of-the-art technical equipment; and the superb office facilities include computerized accounting systems.

Today's CJBQ is a striking example of modern, up-to-date radio station design.
