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# Marathon talks over - BPI and MRS clinch mechanicals deal

AFTER A solid five years of negotiations, the Mechanical Rights Society has reached agreement with the BPI over the entire basis upon which mechanical royalties are paid to publishers.

The two sides eventually came to a compromise over the central dispute in the talks - whether royalties should be paid at the point of manufacture or of retail sale. Legal opinion was split on the issue and neither side has conceded, so it was eventually decided that mechanicals should be paid at the time when discs were shipped trom manufacturer's warehouses.

This typically English solution paved the way to a breakthrough in the marathon talks and the new agreement is now set to run for an initial three years from October 1.

However, there are a number of exceptions to the new rule. Up to 2,000 singles and 1,250 albums of any one title are allowed out royalty-free as promotional copies. There are arrangements to cope with faulty returns, while trade returns can be offset against subsequent ship-outs.

Product sent out to stores as a discount for promotional purposes attracts the full rate of royalty. There were no previous provisions for free issues and this had always been a major bone of contention between the publishers and record producers.

There are special provisions in the 50-page document for TV merchandising companies who are allowed a 25 per cent royalty retention in the first six months after release, falling to ten per cent in the third quarter. The full royalty must be reconciled in the fourth quarter after release.

Although the deal was finally signed late last week, the actual royalty payments have been made on an agreed basis since January. Both sides in the talks are satisfied they have found an

equitable way of calculating royalties against a trade price, and there are no immediate plans for any further BPI-MRS joint trade surveys to fix the average uplift above trade prices of records, although either side can call for one at any stage and the other party must contribute half the costs.

Further provision was made for exports to EEC countries where royalties will be paid at the rate of 61/4 per cent of local prices. Elsewhere abroad royalties will be at the prevailing rate locally usually eight percent.

The agreement has also clarified the deletions situation. Record manufacturers will now pay a royalty of ten percent of invoice.

# **Unwanted 45s** flood into ex-chartshop

VIEWERS OF BBC-2's Oxford Roadshow on Friday evening will be told the amusing story of how promotion companies waste product, postage and packing by sending free singles to a Birmingham shop which ceased selling records four months ago.


The freebies continue to pour in to Midland TV of Bearwood Road, Birmingham at the rate of 20 per week because for eight years the shop made. returns to the industry chart. And although proprietor Robert Lutman informed record companies and the BMRB in August that he was closing the disc side of his well-established business, his shop is still on the so-called 'secret' list of chart return shops held by most of the impact marketing companies.

"I get up to 20 of these free singles a week," said an amused Lutman. "Most of them are unsaleable, but some are the sort of records that get into the charts. For instance, I received two or three copies of 'Save Your Love' by Rene and Renato recently.

"I sell the singles for 50p or £1, and the ones that don't sell are put into a storeroom - there must be thousands of them in there, and I really need the space for other stock.

"When I have sold off my remaining stock of records, that will be it. I haven't made an order for four months, and I hope the free singles will stop coming in soon.'

When questioned about the availability of free promotional 45s – which have been a bone of contention to those dealers not on the chart shop list - most record companies say they are available to those traders visited by salesmen, and the fact that they might be chart return shops is a complete coincidence.

# Thorn EMI drops £20m on VHD

THORN EMI has written off £20 million development costs from its involvement in the ill-fated VHD video disc system which was finally suspended last week.

TE was forced into the decision after setting up a factory in Swindon to manufacture discs because JVC, which was to manufacture the players, pulled out of the joint venture.

The Swindon factory will effectively be closed although part will be retained to work on 'interactive' productions and act as a development centre for the group.

Thorn EMI has already developed an extensive catalogue of programmes for VHD disc and speculation is that these will now be made available on the other video disc systems. EMI Music Video has already released product to the Philip's Laser Vision operation.

on import sales has been stopped in the US and no more will be pressed by Sunnyview.

So far the only 'E.T.' related record to survive the scrutiny of Speilberg is Neil Diamond's 'Heartlight' which it is said was only allowed when MCA won control of the publishing. It is possible that the same could happen with 'E.T. Boogie'.

EMI is currently taking legal advice after MCA had stopped release of 'Home' by Planet Ha Ha. No decision had been taken at press time but Radio DJ Peter Powell tipped the record as a future number one after giving it its only airplay.

The matter is further complicated by an action in America in which MCA is accused of jumping the gun on the release of 'E.T.' storybook album narrated by Michael Jackson. CBS claims that MCA had agreed not to release the album, which features a vocal performance from Jackson, until after Christmas to avoid a clash with the artist's new Epic album Thriller.

"Steven Speilberg has made an historic film and should be allowed to benefit from it. We are quite simply not allowing anyone to use copyright material to their gain. We are stopping them all. People don't pirate Walt Disney and it would be unfair to allow pirate 'E.T.'," them to said Waterman.



# 25% extra for PPL under new BBC deal - Radio-1 ups hours

ALTHOUGH THE record industry failed to get anywhere near its original £9 million asking price for a new needletime agreement with the BBC, it has avoided the delay and expense of a Performing Right Tribunal and negotiated a 25 percent increase in payments under a deal signed last week.

For its part the BBC has secured 30 more hours of recorded music broadcasts, enabling Radio-1 to run independently from Radio-2 for the first time in its 15-year history. A total of 15 extra hours needletime will allow it to run from 6 am to midnight seven days a week from December 4.

A further large share will be taken by Radio-2 and the remainder of the extra hours will be spread around the Radios 3 and 4, the local radio stations and TV. The 19 hours of review time has been maintained.

In the last full year of the PPL-BBC agreement the record industry received £2.8 million. For the first half year of the new deal the BBC will pay £1.7 million, rising to £4.1 million in the first full year from April 1, 1983 and £5 million in the final year of the three-and-a-half-year contract.

PPL general manager John Love said the agreement marked a new stage in broadcaster's thinking about the value of music as programme material.

## Three go in EMI Music moves

EMI MUSIC has incorporated its International Popular Repertoire and Screen Gems departments into the general pop division with a loss of three jobs.

The move involves a complete restructure and Ian Reid, general profes-sional manager, will head the new department.

Responsible to Reid will be Bob Clifford and Stefan Heller, assisted by Ron Sawyer and Judy Karbaron.

The three casualties of the reorganisation are Screen Gems manager Des McCamley, international repertoire department manager Peter Hunsley, and his secretary Pat Williams.

"The old argument about the promotional value of airplay went out with flared trousers," he told RB. "The BBC has recognised just how vital records are to its entertainment package.

Commenting on recommendations in the recent Green Paper on Copyright that record companies should make up their home taping losses by demanding more from broadcasters, Love said: "To make up for those losses we would have to ask £80 million from the BBC, which is plainly ridiculous. The right to play records on air is totally different from the right to home copy."

**Radio-1 controller Derek Chinnery** said: "We are pleased to have made this agreement with PPL which has resulted in a large chunk of extra time for Radio-1. We have achieved our independence from Radio-2 and in 18 months time we will complete the process when new offices at Egton House are opened."

Chinnery stressed that the deal will not mean a cut-back in the number of musicians employed by the BBC and that he would now press for a VHV waveband allocation for Radio-1 from the Home Office.

# **UK support for Midem steady**

WITH AN improved DTI subsidy available for Midem 1983, UK support for the event looks like being at least on a par with this year's event, despite the continuing soft state of the British. recorded music scene.

Concern naturally exists within the Midem organisation about its ability to fill the huge exhibition area in the new Palais des Festivals - unlike Vidcom it will not all be utilised - but a press release mailed from Paris reports that "statistics based on the first 267 companies to confirm their participation" show a 36 percent overall increase in reserved stand space, with a 32 percent increase from British exhibitors. However, what is not pointed out is that the minimum size stand next year comprises four units against three units last January.

Prices have also gone up, on average by about 12 percent, with a stand costing aout £1,650. But against this increase can be set a DTI subsidy amounting to 90 percent of the cost. In January this year, the subsidy only covered 75 percent of a four-unit layout.

Jack Kessler, Midem's UK representative, has already enrolled a strong UK line-up and expects to at least match the 68 companies exhibiting this year. New registrants include TV Records, Nik Powell's Mega Corporation, IDS, Stiletto Records, Lightning, Cherry Red, Metropolis and Some Bizarre. Magnet and Beggar's Banquet are returning to the fold and among other confirmed registrations are Virgin, Red Bus, April Music, Zomba, Pinnacle, PRT, Carlin, Pickwick, Ronco, Chappell/Intersong, Stage 1 and BBC Records.

All stands will be equipped with high performance sound and video equipment, including tri-standard TV monitors

Midem '83 will feature a Classical Market, an equipment section which will feature the Compact Disc. Extensive use will be made of the Palais facilities for live performance. Herbert Von Karajan and the Berlin Philharmonic will be giving a concert, and an all-star pop gala of British, American nd European acts is being asssembled.

# Free EPs feature in Xmas Littlewoods promotion

HOPING TO top last year's 45 per cent from a list of 38 selected top titles. sales boost, High Street multiple Littlewoods is to give away free EPs over the next four weeks in the biggest-ever Autumn campaign to be organised by the chain and its music supplier Record Merchandisers.

The push is designed to encourage the purchase of records and tapes as Christms presents under the banner 'Littlewoods Bring You The Gift of Music.

Special four-track EPs have been compiled for the promotion by Poly-Gram's special projects department, and to qualify for one of the free discs, consumers simply have to buy an album

Promotion plans include 650 16-sheet poster sites nationwide, window and in-store displays in Littlewoods stores, giveaway leaflets on every counter as well as distribution by promotion girls and all the details carried on the current edition of the chain's in-store video.

Record Merchandisers deputy managing director David Hammond commented: "This year's campaign is designed not only to increase sales to Littlewoods' regular customers but also to capitalise on the sales opportunities of the irregular or uncommitted record buyer."

DOES ROD Stewart harbour a death with so far as his *Absolutely Live* 2LP is concerned? Already on its way down after a mere two weeks of inauspicious activity, the album is obviously suffering from the ongoing legal battle between Stewart and manager **Billy Gaff**. Although a 30 percent shareholder in Riva, Stewart has refused to have anything to do with the album and has broken off all contact with his label. However, Gaff and Co are grimly soldiering on and contending with the problems of selling 2.5 million **John Cougar** albums in the States, rather more than the Tartan Terror has done of late. Meanwhile Riva's world ex-US deal with WEA expired in October and talks are being held with various majors. **PolyGram**, sensibly, extended its US contract for Riva, on which Cougar appears, but not Stewart who is, of course, WEA's artist outside the UK, where he's seconded, as it were to Riva.

AS EXPECTED, Harvey Goldsmith's acquisition of Dingwalls Dancehall has developed national ramifications. A chain of nine Dingwalls is to be opened around the country. The first two are in Liverpool and Newcastle with Bristol, Leeds and Blackpool in the pipeline. This will give Goldsmith the opportunity to bring in minor-league American acts on low budget tours, something missing since the college circuit's demise. Boss Goodman will be handling the bookings . . . the RPO's appearance with conductor Louis Clark as the interval attraction at the K-tel-sponsored Miami final of the Orange Bowl football competition, reported here a couple of months back, has taken on a bizarre new twist. Because of 'technical problems' (or maybe the AFM?) the RPO are not able to play live and will therefore be miming their 12-minute spot . . . after Arista, and a few others, too, passed on the Stray Cats for America, EMI took the gamble and has Built For Speed poised to move into the number one album spot, while another Arista-UK act the Thompson Twins is looking hot in the Disco Chart currently . . . Stephen James wishes it to be known that contrary to a report in the Publishing Column last week, DJM is not operating on a skeleton staff following the departures of general manager David Ions and professional manager Dave Pearce. "David Pearce was made redundant and we are looking for a replacement for David Ions. In fact we are planning to expand our publishing activities in the New Year," he says . .

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

Failure to heed the warning could result in an injunction, delivery up of offending copies, damages and costs.

# Conifer 2LP promotion

CONIFER HAS launched a Christmas/ New Year sales promotion under the heading Mixed Doubles. The campaign features 95 double albums from the catalogues of EMI Electrola, RCA Germany and CBS, and includes cassettes. Dealer prices have been reduced by as much as £1.60 until January 31.

## O'Hara on Valentine's new label

VALENTINE MUSIC bows its Valentine label, distributed through IDS, with albums by Mary O'Hara and veteran violinist Max Jaffa.

Mary O'Hara, previously with Chrysalis and Warwick, has recorded A Song For Ireland, which coincides with the publication of a similarly titled book by Michael Joseph. The book, profusely illustrated with photographs of Ireland, contains the lyrics and history of the songs on the LP. The two albums will carry an rrp of  $\pounds4.99$ .

The label is being run by producer Jed Kearse, who already has 12 LPs of military music out on his Bandleader lable, and will follow what he describes as "a policy of releasing high quality MOR music". The two debut releases will be followed in December by an LP entitled *Hawaiian Country* by Wout Stenhuis and, probably in January, by a 20-track album by the Ventures called *Walk Don't Run*.

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

Dealers will have noticed the full-page ad in last week's RB for Street Sounds, the new monthly series of disco compilations to be issued on bot cassette and album, starting in December. As the name similarity may have suggested to some, Street Sounds is the brainchild of Morgan Khan, who also runs the Streetwave label, currently hot with the budget-priced Streetnoise, Vol. 1 album (confused yet?) The launch of the new operation will not affect any existing product in any way, for as sharp-eyed dealers will probably also have noticed, Street Sounds is being marketed through PRT, while Streetwave has been (and will continue to be) distributed by CBS. There are not really any odd politics involved here; the thinking behind it was simply that while CBS should continue to handle the US-originated dance music supplied by Morgan, PRT is in an equally strong position to work strongly with the small-label UK repertoire which will be forming the backbone of the Street Sounds releases. The tracks on the first release (and these were not mentioned in the ad, so you can read them for the first time here) are all of hot, proven pedigree – Raw Silk's 'Do It To The Music', Greg Henderson's 'Dreamin', the Peech Boys' 'Don't Make Me Wait', 'The Message' from Grandmaster Flash; Dunn & Bruce Street's 'Shout For Joy', Inner Life's 'Moment Of My LIfe', and 'Let's Stay Together' by Kadenza. At a suggested sale price of only £2.99 and an hour of playing time, big sales look very likely. Labels with dance-oriented product who feel their titles could benefit from the exposure likely to be generated by Street Sounds, should contact Morgan Khan, as he is interested in featuring anything suitable, be it from indie or major.







#### Album Reviews

NEU!: Black Forest Gateau (Cherry Red B RED 37) Prod: Uncredited THE TRACKS on this album by German band Neu! are all about 10 years old - they were contemporaries of Kraftwerk and Tangerine Dream, but much of it sounds suprisingly fresh with it's Teutonic electronic emphasis. While a few songs tend towards the bland ('Leb Wohl') the more agressive side of the band is evident on side two. A period piece which could appeal to new fans of the genre.

While dealer reaction to the extraordinary 'Save Your Love' by Renee & Renato remains healthy, it nevertheless belies the record's national chart success and allows 'Give Me Fire' by G.B.H. to move even stronger units and leap up to number 2. This reflects the general sales trend this week and sees the 'punk' contributors, yet again, make the most dramatic chart indentations and fluctuations. The four highest new entries, which are all 'punk', are meeting strong early sales, but indications are that, as with the majority of mid-chart entry punk singles, they will experience a relatively short shelf-life and burn themselves out in a comparitively short period of time. Punk releases which could be in a similar position next week and are currently bubbling under, are: Crux & Crash with 'Keep On Running' (No Future, OI 18), 'Eternity' by Drongos For Europe (Inferno, HELL 6) and the Skeptix' 'Routine Machine' (Neon, SKEP 001).

As expected, the new entries from last week's indie album chart have all met with very strong increases in sales, the Adicts' 'Sound Of Music' (Razor) and 'La Variete' by Weekend (Rough Trade) proving to be most exemplary. With Christmas release schedules mostly accomplished by now, the shortage of newer, strong album releases will take effect on the chart in the coming weeks. Dealers will therefore have to largely rely on predictable back-catalogue together with the current chart albums to fulfill a happy Xmas. Having said this, two new compilations - 'The Birth Of Y' (Y, Y 331/3) and 'Burning Ambitions' (Cherry Red, D RED 3) - both look like useful additions for the Christmas racks, and are already achieving healthy sales interest under this week's top LUKE CRAMPTON 30.

# Mason and Ireland **Gould take** Castlebar honours

NEWLY-WED composer Barry Mason and co-composer Don Gould celebrated in style when their composition 'Big Enough For You and Me' took the top prize fund in the 17th Castlebar International Song Contest. The song wins the duo £5,000. In second place was Ireland's own Eurovision winning composer Shay Healy with 'Absence Of Romance', which has now been released as a single by songstress Aileen Pringel. The third prize also went to the English as Mick Greenwood scored with 'A Little Magic'.

In the instrumental section the top £1,000 prize went to French composer Charles Beck and his work 'Regret'. #### LIONEL BICHIE: Lionel Bichie (Motown STMA 8037) Prod: Lionel Richie/James Anthony Carmichael With the single 'Truly' racing up the chart it seems that Richie has finally arrived - after 15 years at the top as a member of The Commodores. It was his duet with Diana Ross on 'Endless Love' which brought him to the public attention and success with this album will affirm in the UK his US status - that of one of the most gifted artists of the last decade.

Film related sales are likely but it's the same old Williams themes

#### JONI MITCHELL: Wild Things Run Fast (Geffen GEF 25102) Prod: Joni Mitchell

Joni Mitchell is an original and a dependable. Her appeal is twofold, not only does she write excellent songs but



her voice, now better than ever, can cope with the most demanding lyric. The single from this album 'You're So Square' is a Leiber & Stoller number delivered with vitality and style and really should have been a hit. The album mixes the rocky music of Court & Spark and the vocal style of Heijira to a satisfying whole.

CHICAGO: If You Leave Me Now (CBS 25133) Prod: James William Guercio/Phil Ramone/Tom Dowd A greatest hits compilation with an ironic title since Chicago has indeed left CBS. Since joining WEA the group has returned to the charts and the material on this album is very strong indeed. Starting as a jazz/rock brassy outfit Chicago soon scored with numbers like '25 Or 6 To 4' but then mellowed to produce such hits as 'If You Leave Me Now', 'Baby What A Big Surprise' and 'Wishing You Were Here'

MALCOLM McLAREN & THE WORLD'S FAMOUS SUPREME TEAM - Buffalo Gals (Charisma MALC 1) Producer - Trevor Horn Former Pistols and Bow Wow Wow manager McLaren surprises and delights with a dynamite dance

After the disappointing 'Thru' These Walls', Collins plays safe with a straight cover of the Supremes' 1966 hit. It's a classic song which has survived the ravages of time well. Collins sings it with style and conviction and will be rewarded with a Top 20 hit.



#### BANANARAMA - Cheers Then (London NANA 3) Producer - Barry Blue

Sarah, Siobhan and Keren's first selfcomposed single is an evocative number which again features all three girls sharing lead vocals. Producer Barry Blue has created a suitably moody and understated accompaniment against which the girls admit the break-up of a relationship. Not commercial enough for the Top 10, but another worthy effort.

#### COSTELLO & **ELVIS** ATTRACTIONS with the ROYAL MeASong(A&MAMS 8266) Produc-GUARD HORNS - Party Party (A&M AMS 8267) Producer - Elvis Costello and Colin Fairley

Costello's recent singles have met with mixed fortunes chartwise, but 'Party Party' - from the forthcoming film of the same name - represents a timely return to form. His new wave aggression has mellowed somewhat, but Costello still has the knack of writing snappy, commercial songs with wide appeal. 'Party Party' is one such tune, with the Royal Guard Horns adding an almost SHARON REDD - In The Name Of Stax-like feel to the proceedings.

THE JAM - Beat Surrender (Polydor POSP 540) Producer – Peter Wilson The Jam's swansong is perhaps the least distinctive '45 they've issued for a long time, borrowing from a barrel load of 60s influences. It's also a highly commercial, energetic workout which should have no problems reaching the top few. A bonus freebie features the Jam's versions of Curtis Mayfield's 'Move On Up', the Chi-Lites' 'Stoned

#### tures an equally attractive 'square dance' version of the tune. A leftfield monster. Out Of My Mind' and Edwin Starr's

'War', all of which are interesting, but unnecessary.

#### KOOL & THE GANG - Hi De Hi, Hi De Ho (De-Lite DE 14) Producer -**Eumir Deodato**

More stylish, high calibre disco from Kool & The Gang on a typical midtempo swayer. Distinctive sweet vocal chorus should prove a winner with Butlin's punters. Chalk up hit number 12 for Kool.

#### PINKEES - Holding Me Tight (Creole CR 42) Producer - Keith Bonsoir

Slower than 'Danger Games', but with the same basic 60's sound of jangling guitars, vocal harmonies and a strong chorus. Ordinarily would do rather well, but will the controversy surrounding 'Danger Games' - highest position in the official industry chart No. 8, and in RB No. 47, - hold it back?

#### SIOUXSIE & THE BANSHEES -Melt!/Il Est Ne Le Divin Enfant (Polydor POSP 539) Producers - Siouxsie & The Banshees

'Melt!' is a moody, atmospheric cut excerpted from the new A Kiss In The Dreamhouse LP which sticks more to conventional song structure than most of Siouxsie's records. 'Il Est' is a charming version of the carol of the same name which should earn Siouxsie her first ever Radio-2 play. The combination of two strong songs should yield Siouxsie's biggest hit for some time.

### THE ELKIE BROOKS - Will You Write er - Gus Dudgeon

Elkie's quivering vocal style is something you either love or hate. Those who take the former line will appreciate 'Will You Write Me A Song', a fairly insubstantial song which takes on a new complexion once Elkie starts her vocal gymnastics. With a number of TV appearances lined-up, it looks like another hit for the former Vinegar Joe vocalist.

#### Love (Prelude PRL A2905) Producer -Eric Matthew

Redd's last single, 'Never Give You Up' 'Beat The Street' was perhaps the best disco record of the year. 'In The Name Of Love' is not in the same league as its illustrious predecessor, but it's still an outstanding record. Redd's band is one of the tightest around, and her vocals are controlled but dominant. All this and a sparkling production should ensure another substantial hit for the 31-year old temptress.



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
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
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
